2. Facility

Valley Inquiry Charter School occupies the facility at 5774 Hazelgreen Rd NE, Salem, OR 97305. Staff and students are present in this facility on a regular basis. This facility is covered by this HASS Plan. This facility is owned and fully maintained by Salem-Keizer Public Schools.

3. Elevated Levels of Lead in Water Used for Drinking or Food Preparation

All school districts, education service districts, and public charter schools are required to test for and eliminate exposure to elevated levels of lead in water used for drinking and food preparation through either remediation or eliminating access, according to OAR 333-061-0400 and OAR 581-022-2223. Because Valley Inquiry Charter School occupies a building owned and fully maintained by Salem-Keizer Public Schools, they are responsible for the testing of lead in water in our building. In conformance with the applicable administrative rules, Salem-Keizer Public Schools certifies the following:

- A. All testing was done according to the testing requirements in OAR 333-061-0400
- B. All samples were analyzed by a laboratory accredited by Oregon Health Authority to test for those materials
- C. All water fixtures required to be tested under OAR 333-061-0400 were tested for elevated levels of lead in accordance with the testing schedule developed by the Oregon Health Authority
- D. The testing schedule for Valley Inquiry Charter School is set forth below:

4. Lead Paint

Valley Inquiry Charter School occupies a building that is owned and fully maintained by Salem-Keizer Public Schools. In order to comply with the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Renovation, Repair, and Painting Program Rule, Salem-Keizer Public Schools will only contract with certified lead-based paint renovation contractors licensed by the Oregon Construction Contractors Board, or use Salem-Keizer Public Schools' staff that are certified by the Oregon Health Authority to perform the work.

5. Asbestos

Valley Inquiry Charter School occupies a building that is owned and fully maintained by Salem-Keizer Public Schools. Salem-Keizer Public Schools complies with the Federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). All required asbestos management plans are available for viewing by submitting a request to Joel Smallwood.

6. Radon

Valley Inquiry Charter School occupies a building that is owned and fully maintained by Salem-Keizer Public Schools. Salem-Keizer Public Schools has developed a radon plan as required by ORS 332.345. 
