Welcome and Introductions

Jennifer motioned and Ashley seconded to approve December 19th, 2021 meeting minutes as presented.

COVID Update (by Mr.Payne):

- It has been a hard week with an explosion of cases where as before we barely had any. VICS has still been less impacted than other school who have had to shut down class and are experiencing staff shortages.
- If your student is showing any symptoms keep them home and if they test positive for COVID notify the school.
